## How to access your immunization record online:

## Sign up for MyIR to View, Download, and Print Your Immunization Information

MyIR allows you to manage your immunization records securely online. Once you register, you can access the records any time you need them. You can also print your child's <u>Certificate of Immunization Status (PDF)</u> for school and child care entry. You can do all of this without an extra trip to your healthcare provider or school.

- Step 1: Go to <a href="https://wa.myir.net/register">https://wa.myir.net/register</a> to begin the sign-up process. If you choose the Auto Match option and the system finds an exact match, MyIR will send you a verification code by either text or phone call. If an exact match is not found, MyIR will direct you to Step 2.
- Step 2: Fill out an <u>Authorization to Release Immunization Records (PDF)</u> or an <u>Autorización para</u> entregar documentos de vacunaciones (PDF) and check the box indicating you want to access your records online via MyIR. Mail, fax, or e-mail the form to:

Once we receive your signed form, we'll register you in MyIR and send you a temporary PIN and instructions on what to do next. When you're done, you'll have immediate access to your family's immunization records to view, download, or print as often as you need. ## **How to apply for insurance:**

Applying for Apple Health Medicaid and/or a Qualified Health Plan, you have several options:

- **Online**: Go to <u>washingtonhealthplanfinder.org</u> select the "Apply Now" button.
- Mobile app: Download the <u>WAPlanfinder app</u> select "sign in" or "create an account".
- **Phone**: Call the Washington Healthplanfinder Customer Support Center at 1-855-923-4633.
- Paper: Submit an Application for Health Care Coverage (18-001P).
- **In-person**: Local resources at any HealthPoint; request to speak to Client Services Representative.

## When you are ready to apply, you'll need this information:

- Your household monthly income.
- The Social Security numbers and dates of birth for each member of your household.
- Your immigration information, if that applies to you.
